WWII Air Sea and Land Festival (ASLF)

We are on the eve of the National WWII Air Sea and Land Festival this weekend, October 12-15. Our Unit is excited to participate in a big way

for the first time. Our new Stearman is not yet approved for the rides program but we will have the aircraft on static display. This year, we will need every able-bodied member to come out and volunteer. Please see the sign-up roster posted in newsletter.

The set-up day is Thursday, Oct. 11 starting at 8am and running all day. We will set up in

two places, the main hangar with an information table and our tent with the PX. We will also assist the WWII folks and the visiting CAF crews as needed.



On show days, I recommend that all AM volunteers (those arriving before the gates open at 9) report to our hangar to receive your airshow credentials. PLEASE WEAR YOUR

BIG EASY WING KASTRACK BADGE. This identifies you as a wing member. If you have not received one and are eligible, we should have provisions to get you yours during the show. As for the WWII credentials, they will be available at the hangar before the gates open and at the PX tent after that. Those will be assigned daily and must be returned at the end of your shift. This is important since we have only a limited number of them.

Parking is available in the Ball Park area as in previous years, or for early arrivers, outside the gate in front of our hangar. Parking is FREE.

Our unit duties will include manning an information tent in the main show hangar (like last year) and running our PX tent. This will allow for great exposure for our unit. Last year, we recruited 21 new members at this event alone. One can only imagine, now with two hangar spaces, two planes and nearly 100 members, what we can do with your help this year.

On Saturday night, our unit will host a small meet and greet in the hangar after the show around 5 or 6 pm. We are looking for donations of food, wine and soft drinks. All members of the wing, family, friends and potential members are invited to attend the party. This will be a great opportunity to meet the new CAF president, Hank Coates and his officer corps. We will also have visiting CAF crews from around the country. A great opportunity for us!


