Maintenance Officer's Report —Sonny Schilleci

Greetings Troops,

An update from the Maintenance side of the house.

As most everyone is aware we are now caring for our Stearman and 7/10 scale replica Junkers Ju 87 Stuka Dive Bomber (Sturzkampfflugzeug). We are currently taking care of some minor maintenance items on the Stearman and have started a thorough inspection of the Stuka in anticipation of returning it to flight status. Although the Stuka is in

the Experimental category and cannot be used for the rides program we strongly believe it will be a highly sought after aircraft for static display at airshows and aviation events as it is a one of a kind aircraft.

Stuka update: We will be replacing all rubber hoses and any non-aviation hardware with all new FAA approved parts. We found a patch that was done to the left fuel tank that we did not like so the tank was removed and it will undergo a weld repair for a permanent fix. Oil analysis was performed on the engine and no abnormalities were noted. We will perform another analysis at 25 hours flight time once we are going again.



Stearman update: Currently on condition maintenance only.

Both aircraft will require ADS-B upgrades for the upcoming mandate and could use some good radios installed as well. Any donation for these items and maintenance will

be greatly appreciated.

We were also left with a hangar full of broken Warbirds after the WWII Land, Air and Sea Event. I want to send a special thanks to Terry Clausing who has been at the hangar on a daily basis to not only work on our aircraft but has been donating his time working on the aircraft from other Wings. Thank you Terry!
