The Big Easy Wing played host to the Andrew J. Higgins Squadron of the United States Sea Cadet Corps (USNSCC) on Saturday the 23rd of March in which the squadron held its annual unit and personnel inspection, as well as an awards and promotions ceremony for many of the cadets. Two members of the Big Easy Wing were in attendance - Jim Letten who gave a very inspiring talk to the cadets and their families in attendance, and J.D. Olson who was asked to conduct the personnel inspection. Both had been asked to participate in the day-long affair by the squadron's commanding officer, Lieutenant Junior Grade (SCC) José Campuzano who did a masterful job in coordinating and leading the event throughout the day.

The USNSCC is a national youth leadership development organization that promotes interest and skill in naval disciplines while instilling strong moral character and life skills through leadership and technical programs modeled after the Navy's professional development system. Its goals and objectives mesh very closely with those of the Commemorative Air Force whose mission is to educate, inspire and honor through flight those who served in the air arms of the U.S. military branches during World War II. Winning that war, in fact, led to the establishment of many fine American youth programs such as the Sea Cadets who trace their beginnings to 1962, less than a decade after the founding of the CAF.

Fundraiser—Give NOLA Day—Shirley Colomb


