Safety on the ramp has been a concern of mine for some time. We've discussed it at meetings and done some training in anticipation of the

time when there's more happening at the BEW than our Stearman taxiing down a straight ramp and stop-

ping. So after our recent Warbird weekend at Lakefront Airport that included a B-17, JRB/C-

45, SNJ/T-6 and our N2S/PT-17 on the Ballpark ramp together some reflection is in order. While it consisted of only four aircraft it still wasn't an easy layout to manage. There was one entry/exit point in the middle of the ramp and one of the aircraft had a 104' wingspan. We wanted some aircraft to be able to depart/arrive while the others had spectators walking around them and we didn't want them to be too far from the spectator

line. That



took a lot of work and coordination from the BEW members working on the ramp as Marshallers in Training and working on the rope line, and in a word I thought they did GREAT. The rope line went up and down when needed, we adapted as the aircraft layout changed and aircraft came and went without incident. I'm impressed with how everyone performed. as I know of several things I will do differently next time (it was my first time organizing something like this), and also will NOT do next time, but if you look back to where we were 9 months ago we've come a long way. Thank you




PX Officer's Report-Shirley Colomb
