We are awaiting a decision on the Stearman annual inspection. We are hoping that Jim Shaw will still be available as the I.A. to sign-off on the annual inspection. Note: the Stearman had several major upgrades completed in 2019 and early 2020 so we anticipate a timely review.

On the Stuka, I have inspected the ignition harness and their O.K. I have installed an external power connector, so jumping in the back seat with jumper cables will no longer be required as well as performed sheet metal repairs around the tail wheel jack/tow bar tube. Next major repair will be the magnetos. I will be removing them and sending them out for overhaul.






XO Officer—KAStrack Update—Robert Claypool

KAStrack now allows members to easily pay their local Big Easy Wing membership online. As an added bonus, this automatically registers your payment within the system, and turns your certification GREEN.

Steps:


Log into KAStrack at https://cafbew.kastrack.com:



After entering your username and password, you will be brought to your Dashboard. Expand the People Menu on the left hand side, and click My Account:



Your list of Outstanding Requirements will be at the top. Click on the Complete Form or Payment link to the right of the BEW Dues Requirement.




This will open the following dialog allowing you to Pay. Note that Active Military may enter "Military" to receive their military discount. Cadets may enter "Cadet" to receive theirs.





Once you have clicked the Pay button above, a new dialog box opens which is directly connected to the merchant account. CAF / KAStrack does not store any credit card information.



As a result of this, you will need to enter your email address so that the merchant (Stripe) can send you a receipt. After inputting your information, click the Pay button which should have the correct amount you are to be charged listed. If it does not, please cancel the transaction and try again.
