Pat Quigley to Receive FAA Wright Brothers Award



While we had what I viewed as an excellent fire control presentation at our March membership meeting, I would like to review some of what was discussed. One aspect of importance was the use of two people on the wheeled extinguisher at the flight ramps and engine test runs. What we need is one person working the extinguisher and one person to maneuver the handcart. Also, remember the different class of extinguishers:

A- ordinary (wood and paper) B- liquid fuels

C- electrical D- combustibles K- kitchen fires

When operating the extinguisher think of the acronym—P.A.S.S.

P-pull pin A-Aim at fire S-Squeeze handle S-Sweep side to side
