


#### **Night Meetings Again?**

# **Proposed Runway Closer**

Proposed runway closure of Lakefront's Crosswind runway, 9 / 27 is still an important issue. The airport authority has proposed closing this runway, which is our only crosswind option at this airport. This is of VITAL importance, as on many occasions we would not be able to fly at all with winds out of the East or West. Not only would this hamper our ability to fly these historical aircraft, but it would also greatly affect all of the general aviation aircraft based at Lakefront and keep people from visiting.

Feel free to contact to the Airport Management authority, the FAA, and the Mayor, and call any one of these people listed below. Please let them know how important Lakefront Airport Runway 9 / 27 is to local flight operations and insist to them that it cannot be closed!
