

Our biggest challenge and limiting factor to the pilot group continues to be having more than one option for a local instructor pilot. In the near term, we are pursuing every avenue to get our squadron IP current again so that we can continue to maintain and grow our pilot fleet. The long-term solution will be to have more than one local Stearman IP, so that is what we will continue to strive for. We will continue to fly the Stearman when pilot availability and weather permits, and I want to make sure that anyone who has paid to sponsor the airplane has gotten a chance to go flying in it.

Work continues on the Stuka replica-Terry Clausing has finally solved the wire harness issue that had plagued the airplane for a while on engine run-ups. The plane will require some more work and a conditional inspection (an annual for experimental aircraft) in order to be able to take to the skies again. Stay tuned.
