October, what a beautiful month for many reasons. Generally, the weather is ideal with a small touch of autumn thrown into the mix. This past month was no








### Election Chair— James Mykris

### Safety Officer—Rick Wood



Good day to everyone!

I would like to remind everyone about things to look out for and take precautions for the upcoming chilly weather.

Chimney: Fireplaces need to be inspected for cracks. Birds tend to build nest in chimneys in the spring. If you do not have screens to block them the nest can catch fire. Hiring a Chimney sweeper to maintain and clean your fireplace is a clever idea.



Central heating system: Electric heaters need to be turned on to burn off the dust collected on the heating element during the summer ( this is what causes the burnt smell)

Gas furnaces: Heating chamber needs to be checked for cracks to eliminate CO2 getting into the house. It is a good idea to install CO2 detectors in the house. Also CHANGE THE FILTERS for best heat exchange

One big problem we have every year is people misusing space heaters. Most house fires are caused by people running them off power stripes or placing them to close to furniture or drapes.

I hope this reminder will help keeps you safe during our upcoming winter.
