Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!

We are currently developing our course curriculum for the Kaydet Training Program for the Boy Scouts, and this is the month we will be looking for volunteers to sign up as instructors. There are requirements from the Boy Scouts, that need to be met in order to be qualified as, what they call, a "Merit

Badge Counselor". The process is pretty straight forward. It consists of completing the Boy Scouts Youth Protection Training, BSA Online Merit Badge Counselor Training, and submit to a Criminal Background Check.

Instructors will be needed for the following topics:

Safety - Airport Operations (Airport layout, markers & signs, Tower functions & the language they use.

Aerodynamics (What makes airplanes fly, the forces that act on an airplane, how does an airfoil generate lift, etc.)

Aviation (Explain operation of piston, turboprop, and jet engines, explain various certification)

Charts & Navigation (How does GPS work, Aeronautical Chart terminology, plot a course on the chart

Aircraft Pre-Flight (How to pre-flight an airplane, what is a pilot looking for) Flight Simulator Operation (Parts of the simulator, demo flying skill, fly a plotted course from New Orleans Lakefront to Slidell or Hammond airport)

Careers in Aviation (Job responsibility, income, need in today's job market)

I am confident that we have the talent within our Wing to successfully instruct young people in these areas, so please indicate your interest to Shirley or myself. We look forward to having instructors in place by the beginning of the new year, and hope to begin the Kaydet Training Program by March of 2024.
